

Standing Committees (Appointed Positions)

Historian: The Historian will preserve memorabilia of WWI to record its accomplishments in historical order, and will solicit items from Members to include in the historical record book.

1. The Historian collects articles, photographs, and items pertaining to the history of Wyoming Writers, Inc. and its Members.
2. The Historian maintains all scrapbooks that are the property of WWI and adds to them during the year.
3. The Historian may keep copies of the *WYO-Writer* along with the scrapbooks.
4. The Historian must take or send all WWI scrapbooks to the Annual Conference for the benefit of Members.
5. The Historian will write periodic articles for the *WYO-Writer* requesting items of memorabilia from Members for inclusion in the scrapbook, and the Historian's name and contact information will be listed in the *WYO-Writer* so members will know where to send items for inclusion in the historical record.

The job entails reading the newspapers and collecting articles about Wyoming authors.

Members mail clippings to me from all over the state. I read the Casper Star Tribune, but I clip very little as the members have been very good about getting the information to me. Usually they are kind enough to send in lots of materials.

You then assemble the articles into a scrapbook, along with copies of the WWI newsletters.

This job takes under an hour a month. There isn't much to this job = it's pretty easy duty.
